

# Understanding the Progress Report

Knowing how your child is performing in their courses is something important to all parents and guardians. The below example shows a student at risk because, although they are scoring well on the work they are completing, they are *behind pace* to complete the course by the target date and may not have time to finish all assignments.

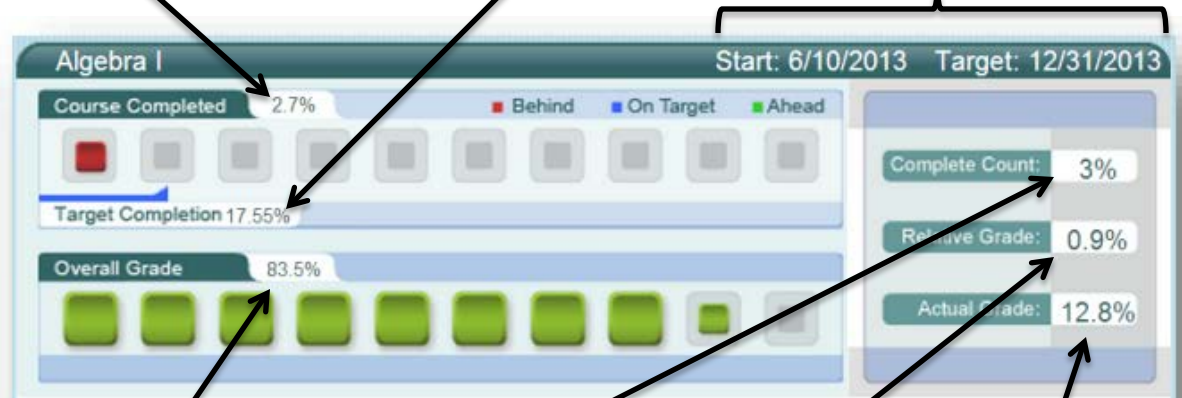

Pacing

How much of the course student **HAS completed** so far

How much of the course student **SHOULD have completed** by now

**Start Date and Target Complete Date** are set by the teacher for each student



this student has *fallen behind* pace to complete on target time

this student has *low actual grade* compared to *overall grade* because they are behind pace

Grade student has earned **THUS FAR for work completed** so far

Percent of assignments student **HAS completed** so far

Grade student **would receive** if they stopped all work, getting 0% on unfinished assignments

The **overall student grade** adjusted for progress.
